**Can-Do Conservatives Endorse Murphy for Congress**

Lawrenceville, GA--The national conservative group representing the interests of the disabled, Can-Do Conservatives, have endorsed Mike Murphy in his bid to unseat Dan Burton in Indiana's 5th Congressional District. In 2008, Mike Murphy authored a bill that was signed into law mandating fair treatment of the insured in regards to prosthetic limb replacement. HB 1140, requires that insurers reimburse the insured for prosthetic devices at least at the Medicare reimbursement rate if certain requirements were met. The net effect of this legislation was to prevent insurance companies from capping the amount or quality of prosthetic limb replacements if medical necessity dictates a need.

Can-Do Conservatives was started by Brian Donegan, founder and CEO, following his active volunteering for presidential candidate Mike Huckabee in addition to his role as a grass roots coordinator. Based out of Lawrenceville, Georgia, Brian already has been the featured speaker at various republican gatherings and will be speaking at the upcoming "Defending the American Dream Summit" put on by Americans for Prosperity on March 27th.

"Can-Do Conservatives are an engine for change. I believe I can do the same thing if sent to Washington by the voters of the 5th district. I am happy that the Can-Do Conservatives see promise in my candidacy to deliver that change," Murphy said.
